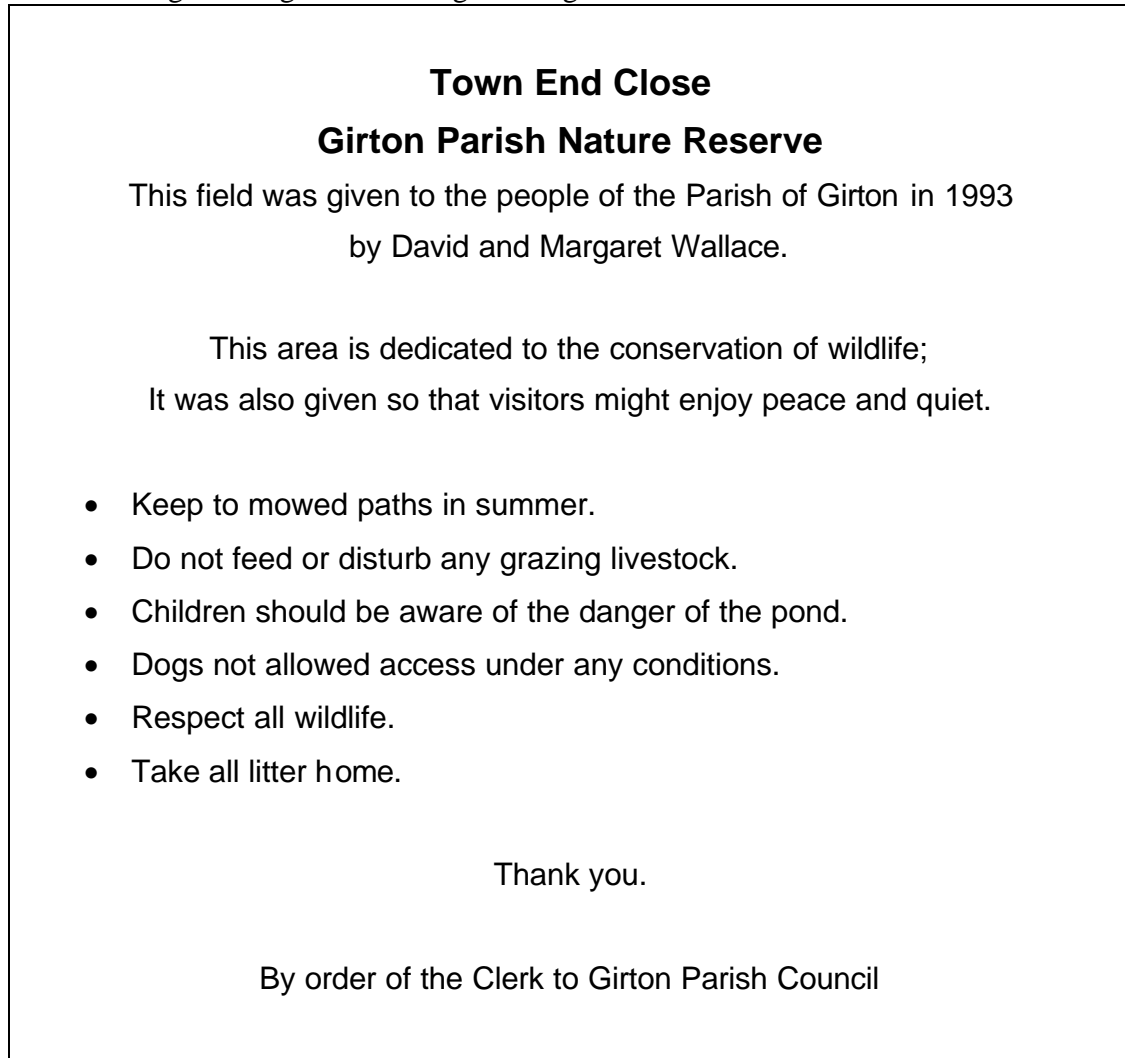

09/80 To agree a style of bus shelter at Girton Corner as part of budgeting for 2010/2011.

Several photographs of a suitable bus shelter in Cottenham were circulated for comment. This design had been costed from £2400 to £3025. Perch seating was available. The positioning of the shelter needed to be carefully considered to provide access for buses, shelter passengers, and permit use of the pavement by pedestrians. The footpath was 2.6m wide, and a 1.2m walkway was needed for pushchairs and wheel chairs.

Prior to making an order a site survey would be needed by the company, and inquiries made of the statutory undertakers to determine whether service pipes were present under the pavement at that point.

The Chairman would discuss action points with the Clerk.
