09/66 To consider whether to support Cambridgeshire County Council's proposal for two new disabled parking places at St Vincent's Close, Girton.

It was noted that this issue had been referred to Girton Parish Council for comment by one of the County Council's Traffic Technicians. Following a short discussion it was agreed to support this proposal for two new disabled parking spaces adjacent to 108 St Vincents Close.

09/67 To note Cambridge City Council's consultation on a draft Public Art Supplementary Planning document, and to decide whether to make representations.

The Chairman explained that this was needed to support the delivery of public art in new developments in Cambridge using Section 106 monies. The aim of the document was to provide guidance. Girton Parish Council was being consulted as a neighbouring parish to the city.

It was decided that no comments were necessary, and that no representations were required.

09/68 To note South Cambridgeshire DC's planning update for parish councils at April 2009 with particular reference to key reporting dates for the NIAB, and NW Cambridge sites.

This useful planning update document for parish councils was noted. The Clerk drew Councillors' attention to the timetable for Government Inspector reports. The intention was to publish an early part report for the land between Huntingdon Road and Histon Road (*the NIAB site*) by the end of June, and the full report in July. The Inspectors binding report on the NW Cambridge Area Action Plan would be published in July.
