	Cllr Carney highlighted comments he had received from Residents regarding Manor Farm planning application (See Agenda Item 22/129.12, 4 <sup>th</sup> January 2023). He asked GPC Clerk if these comments could be raised under this section of the agenda. GPC Clerk agreed.	
	Comments received as below:	
	<ul> <li>The dog training facility was never activated. So, it is unreasonable to compare noise levels, car usage etc. with something that never happened. (Paras 13.2, 16.6-8).</li> </ul>	

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	<ul> <li>It is a moot point as to whether the granting of the planning permission for the previous project was sound given the subsequent history of the applicant. 3.</li> <li>The change of use is to industrial production in the Green Belt. This is different from changing from agriculture to animal training and grooming. South Cambs are supposed to be protecting the Green Belt. (See 11.4)</li> <li>The application is for use 7 days a week. This would be unacceptable under any circumstances. (See 13.6).</li> <li>Paras 16.3 and 16.8 say only 4 employees would be travelling for two journeys a day and staying at the site. Nowhere in the application is there mention of transport of ingredients into the development or out of it with produce. What size of transport is proposed, how many times a day, how often per week, how many additional "employees" involved? Would the vehicles be electric?</li> <li>Flood zone: the map is incorrect as the Beck is considered to be in flood zone 3a. See South Cambs own map: https://www.scambs.gov.uk/media/7983/d1-flood-zone-maps.pdf. Any extra run off from hard landscaping should be protected by SUDS (not mentioned). Where is the transport for the incoming of ingredients and exiting of produce going to arrive, sit and depart? Mention is made of no problem with the cutting down of trees, but any removal of trees will increase the runoff and therefore the flood risk at times of high rainfall. See paras 9.1 and 14.1. 7.</li> <li>We think this should be refused but if the Council disagree there should be confirmation that at no time will a retail outlet be included at the</li> </ul>	
Cllr Hayat a	<ul> <li>cllr Carney had reviewed the above comments and revisited the information submitted to support the application ahead of tonight's meeting. He noted that whilst GPC Planning Committee decision to Support the Application could not be overturned, he did want to ensure the Planning Committee had time to consider the comments: <ul> <li>Comments made by Girton resident are recorded on the GCP Planning portal and will be available for the GCP Planning meeting.</li> <li>From reviewing the plan there appeared to be no plans to increase hard landscaping beyond what is currently in place.</li> <li>It does not appear apparent that trees will be cut down.</li> </ul> </li> <li>rrived at 18:38 <ul> <li>Cllr Muston had reviewed the application again on receipt of the comments provided by Cllr Carney. She noted the points made about the inaccuracy of the map regarding the Flood Zone and that there could be a request for two for one planting of trees.</li> <li>Cllr Marshall felt the information submitted for this application confirmed a focus on achieving climate friendly outcomes.</li> <li>Cllr Giles noted that if a retail outlet was suggested then it would need to be a separate planning application.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
