### **Capital Projects 2024/2025**

Girton Parish has an ongoing capital project plan. Each project is brought forward for approval as and when it is ready for implementation. If there are any spend in addition to the £45K request for Capital Projects above then this will be funded from S106 funds and reserves held in place by Girton Parish Council.
