January 2024

Happy New Year to Girton Parish and Girton Parish Council.

This is probably the one of the most important meetings of the year as our budget setting comes together and we plan our projects for the financial year 2025/2026.

This could be an exciting year for Girton as Council considers possible next steps on the Master Plan exercise from next year. The 249 responses from Girton Parish Council Survey increased from 94 responses will feed into those next steps.

Girton Parish Council will also produce a report to confirm the rationale of our precept request following our Full Council meeting on 15th January 2025.

We have secured four pages in February edition of Girton Parish News to ensure that information on both the Master Plan next steps and setting the precept, so that this information hits every door mat in Girton.

We also await information from the Wildlife Trust who has agreed to provide funding to undertake work to improve the areas around the two balancing ponds at Wellbrook Way.

This year we will set up a series of events so that Girton Parish Council can ensure that our community is consulted on all these initiatives.

Within the Council our focus will be on governance and increasing accessibility to information that might be of interest to our Community. Look out for more news on this in the next few weeks.
